ProNerve Internship Program

ProNerve employs two types of intraoperative neuro-monitoring service providers. CNIMs (Certification in Neurophysiologic Intraoperative Monitoring) is the first type and D.ABNMs (Diplomat of the American Board of Neurophysiologic Monitoring) is the second type. CNIMs are generally Bachelors trained, and D.ABNMs are Masters trained.

If you are entering the field of intraoperative neuro-monitoring for the first time, and you are Bachelors or Masters trained, you may be eligible for the ProNerve Internship Program. Interns must meet certain criteria and enter a comprehensive training program sponsored by ProNerve in conjunction with American NeuroDiagnostics (AND).

Once an Intern completes his/her program, which may take from six months to a year, they are eligible for placement at a ProNerve site. Compensation is dependent upon achieving certain milestones, including CNIM or D.ABNM, and other skills achievements.

Career Growth Potential

Due to academic standing and scope of practice guidelines, ProNerve makes a distinction between CNIMs (technicians) and D.ABNMs (clinicians). Both CNIMs and D.ABNMs include the following grades:

1. Board eligible
2. Certified-Standard
3. Certified-Advanced

Compensation is tied to these grades and follows the natural progression of a technician or clinician through the ranks, from Intern to Certified Advanced. ProNerve supports continuing education and through its affiliations with academic and private institutions, it sponsors a variety of programs geared towards advancement.
